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The section below summarizes the work done during the month of February 2020.

CAPACITY BUILDING

On February 23-29, 2020 Horanimana Grace and Misago Gisele, two of FWA trauma healing facilitators attended HROC advanced training at HROC Musanze center in Rwanda.

ACTIVITIES

Caring for HIV Positive People (CHIVPP)

During this month of February 2020, medical follow up and home visits were done for our HIV positive people. The African great Lakes Initiatives of the Friends Peace Teams has supported FWA to order a vehicle from Japan. This vehicle will be at FWA at the end of April 2020. It will be helpful for FWA coordination and transportation for HIV positive people when they need some special tests in the countryside hospitals.



Maternity Ward Building

In the month of February 2020, we were able to do wooden rafters. We have bought iron sheets that will be on our building very soon.

Improving Women's Reproductive Health (IWRH)

FWA community health workers and FWA staff have continued to educate men, women and young people on the importance of family planning.



Rape Survivors' Support (RSS)



One three-day trauma healing workshop was done in February 2020.

My name is Joselyne. I had a baby girl during my first pregnancy. When my husband learned that I have a baby girl in my womb, He beat me until I aborted. Even my following children were girls. Then my husband started to sell all our lands. Because of anger, I uprooted all the limits of the lands he had sold. They called the police to arrest me, and I ran away from home. I was finally found, and I was put in jail. Even today I still feel hurt because of what my husband did. My husband swore that he will never pay school fees for my daughters. I'm in charge of my four daughters' education. Because of my trauma, I lost my fifth kid. I have not yet found her.

Eight new Self-Help Groups (SHGs) were initiated in the month of February 2020. At the end of February 2020, we had a total of 78 SHGs for a total of 1788 women.

MEDICAL TEAM

CONSULTATIONS

132 cases were consulted by our medical doctors, including 69 adults (45 women and 35 men), 12 children (9 girls and 3 boys), 26 HIV positive people and 25 pregnant women for ultrasound. The nurse received 368 patients including 229 adults and 139 children.

LABORATORY

In the month of February 2020, apart from HIV voluntary testing, there were a total of 378 tests.

FAMILY PLANNING

369 people received contraceptives from FWA's nurse, including 250 old cases and 119 new ones. 287 received the contraceptive injection, 44 were given pills, 30 received male condoms, and 8 received implants.

PRENATAL CONSULTATION (PNC)

In the month of February 2020, 36 women came for prenatal consultation (PNC), including 17 who came for PNC 1, 5 for PNC 2 and 9 for PNC 3 and 4 for PNC 4
25 pregnant women came for the ultrasound test.

ANTI-RETROVIRAL SITE

At the end of February 2020, we had 330 patients under retro drugs followed at NTASEKA clinic, including 267 women and 63 men.

PHARMACY

Regarding medications, FWA was able to purchase the minimum needed medicine.

PSYCHOSOCIAL TEAM

In the month of February 2020, a total of 62 people received pre and post HIV test counseling and were tested for HIV. Out of the total number, 69% were women and two people out the five people detected HIV positive were women, with 8% of seropositivity.
