Rape Survivors' Support (RSS)

In the month of December, the Rape Survivors Support program had different activities: one trauma healing workshop for GBV perpetrators, the creation, the supervision and the evaluation of Self-Help Groups (SHGs).

I married a woman but she did not respect me. She frequented the bars to drink beer every day. A woman who drinks and comes home late deserves to be beaten for little correction; I beat her and we quarreled every day.

To punish me well she became pregnant with another man and she spoke it out loudly. I felt shame in the community because almost everyone knew that the pregnancy she had was from another person.

I could not support that, I beat her and she leaves me with 3 children. My children are with my mother until now and I became alcoholic because I was really touched by this incident.

In my life I don't want to see a woman because I see her as a devil. Thanks a lot for giving me this opportunity to share my story.

The Self-Help Groups have continued to meet once a week. At the end of December 2021, we had a total of 142 SHGs in Kamenge, Bujumbura Mairie province for a total of 3363 women and 30 SHGs for 738 women in Nyabiraba commune, Bujumbura province.

- > Interest generated by 28 SHGs credits : 75,205,600 **BIF** (\$37,792)
- > People who have not paid back : 31
- > Total money not refunded : 3,229,150 **BIF** (\$1,623)

With the support of the Ministry of National Solidarity, Social Affairs, Human Rights and Gender, we have implemented the frames and roofs of 19 houses of first nations people houses. They are staying on Bubaji hill, Nyabiraba commune in Bujumbura province. As this project comes to prevent GBV, legal marriage was the main criteria to benefit from this donation.









MEDICAL TEAM

CONSULTATIONS

Our medical doctor consulted with 46 cases, including 12 adults (1 man and 11women), four children (2 boys and 2 girls), 21 HIV positive people and 9 pregnant women for ultrasound. The nurse received 242 patients including 177 adults and 65 children.

LABORATORY

In the month of December 2021, apart from HIV voluntary testing, there were a total of 285 tests.

FAMILY PLANNING

506 people received contraceptives from FWA's nurse, including 283 old cases and 223 new ones. 381 received the contraceptive injection, 69 were given contraceptive pills, 43 received male condoms, 1 UID and 12 received implants.

PRENATAL CONSULTATION (PNC)

In December 2021, 27 women came for prenatal consultation (PNC), including 12 who came for PNC 1, 8 for PNC 2, 4 for PNC 3 and 3 for PNC 4. 9 pregnant women came for the ultrasound test.

ANTI-RETROVIRAL SITE

At the end of December 2021, we had 330 patients under retro drugs followed at NTASEKA clinic, including 267 women and 63 men.

PHARMACY

Regarding medications, FWA was able to purchase the minimum needed medicine.

PSYCHOSOCIAL TEAM

In the month of December 2021, 58 people were tested for HIV and received pre and post HIV test counselling. Of these 58, no one was detected HIV positive with 0% of seropositivity.
