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COVID-19 AND NTASEKA CLINIC

In the month of December, Friends Women's Association has continued to apply covid restrictions at Ntaseka Clinic for both the staff and the beneficiaries' protection.

ACTIVITIES

Caring for HIV Positive People (CHIVPP)

In the month of December, medical follow-up and home visits were done for our HIV positive people.

On December 1st, 2023, the FWA joined the world to celebrate the International Day against HIV/AIDS. There were testimonies from Ntaseka clinic beneficiaries, the local authorities were represented and local partner organizations were there. At the end of the event, those who were there danced because of joy and then Ntaseka clinic beneficiaries were given food to share with their families on that special day.

Maternity Ward Building

Although Ntaseka maternity ward still needs some medical equipment; both the delivery and the hospitalization services are currently functional.

Improving Women's Reproductive Health (IWRH)

FWA community health workers and FWA staff have continued to educate men, women and young people on the importance of birth control.

Rape Survivors' Support (RSS)

In the month of December, the Rape Survivors Support program had different activities: the supervision of Self-Help Groups (SHGs). At the end of December 2023, we had a total of 159 SHGs in Kamenge, Bujumbura Mairie province for a total of 3763 women and 43 SHGs for 1063 women in Nyabiraba commune, Bujumbura province.

ACTION ON GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE (AGBV)

In the month of November, in the context of the project "Connecting the Global to the Local: Strengthening Women's Leadership for the Localization of the United Nations Security Council Resolution 1325 (2000) on "Women, Peace and Security", seven psychologists and 132 psychologists' assistants have been receiving gender-based violence survivors for both listening and counselling. There were also field visits to introduce psychologists to the local authorities

In the month of December, under the support of the Canadian Friends Service Committee (CFSC), the FWA organized a public event to stand against GBV in Nyabiraba Commune, Bujumbura province

MEDICAL TEAM

CONSULTATIONS

Our medical doctors consulted with 206 cases, including 80 adults (37 men and 43 women), 15 children (7 boys and 8 girls), 22 HIV positive people and 89 pregnant women for ultrasound. The nurse received 300 patients including 208 adults and 92 children.

LABORATORY

In the month of December, apart from HIV voluntary testing, there were a total of 368 tests.

FAMILY PLANNING

444 people received contraceptives from FWA's nurse, including 267 old cases and 177 new ones. 427 received the contraceptive injection, 4 were given contraceptive pills, 2 received male condoms at Ntaseka clinic, 2 received UID and 9 received implants

PRENATAL CONSULTATION (PNC)

In December, 42 women came for prenatal consultation (PNC), including 12 who came for PNC 1, 13 for PNC 2, 6 for PNC 3 and 11 for PNC 4.

89 pregnant women came for the ultrasound test.

ANTI-RETROVIRAL SITE

At the end of December, we had 330 patients under retro drugs followed at NTASEKA clinic, including 267 women and 63 men.

PHARMACY

Regarding medications, FWA was able to purchase the minimum needed medicine.

PSYCHOSOCIAL TEAM

In the month of December, 81 people were tested for HIV and received pre and post HIV test counselling. Out of them, four women were detected HIV positive with 5% of seropositivity.
